The Women's Fund Miami-Dade, Stop Sex Trafficking Miami, and NOW (U of Miami) present *TRICKED*, an unflinching view of child sex trafficking in the United States

Miami, FL – The Women's Fund together with Stop Sex Trafficking Miami and NOW (University of Miami) is pleased to announce a special screening of *TRICKED*, a documentary about sex trafficking in the United States on September 16th, 7 p.m. at the Bill Cosford Cinema. The film will be followed by a panel discussion with Jane Wells, producer of *TRICKED*, Nancy Ratzan, Chair, Stop Sex Trafficking Miami, and Rafael Hernandez, State Attorney Officer and distribution of action kits for attendees to help build a movement in Miami to stop the sale of our children for sex.

TRICKED is an eye-opening documentary that weaves together the experiences of those involved in the \$3 billion dollar a year industry of sex trafficking in the United States. The film provides an inside look at the disturbing bonds between traffickers and victims, along with the countless challenges faced by law enforcement across the country.

The evening prior to the screening, on September 15th at 7 p.m., NOW at UM will hold a candle light vigil on the Foote Green at the University of Miami campus in support of the victims of sex trafficking. The vigil will kick off a crowdfunding campaign called Everyone's Kids, Everyone Gives Day, a national, 24 hour giving day that will mobilize hundreds of organizations and thousands of people on a single day across the country to help fight child sex trafficking in the United States.
